

Application Guideline:

The criteria for applying is as below,

- The applicant is an artist, curator or art writer.
- The applicant must be between the age of **25 to 45 years of age**, of Indian nationality, residing presently and over the past year in India.
- The residency applied for must have been in existence for at least 3 years. The residency period should be for a maximum of 6 weeks but no less than 4 weeks
- The applicant must have experience as a visual arts professional of at least 3 years.
- All completed application forms along with required documents and materials should be submitted to the online google application form as a single PDF file (no more than 20 MB).

Application:

To apply please submit the following on our online portal by the **5th of June, 2019**.

- Completed application form (download **here**)
- An official invitation from the residency, mentioning exacts dates of the residency.
- Portfolio (PDF, 10 MB) . Portfolio can consist of the following,
 - a. images of artworks and/or installation shots (not more than 20)
 - b. Hi-res video (links, not more than 4)
 - c. sound files (links not more than 4)
 - d. writing samples (1000 words, not more than 2)
 - e. A combination of the above shall be submitted where total numbers of items are not more than 5.
- CV (2 pages)

Selection Process:

- The deadline for the applications is **5th June, 2019**
- The selection of the Awardee would be done by a selected jury panel
- The grant must be availed of within 9 months from the date of the award
- Announcement of the Grant Awardee: **15th July, 2019**

Terms & Conditions:

- Serendipity Arts Foundation will be responsible for booking tickets for the awardee, and will also bear the cost of the visa.
- The grant money will be used only towards the travel and visa fees of the applicant. All additional expenses are to be borne by the applicant.
- Once the ticket has been booked, any last minute changes and additional cost to ticket change will be borne by the applicant.
- No relatives or extended family members of the Serendipity Arts Foundation team are eligible to apply for the grant.
- The Applicant should not have attended any residency in the past.

- The applicant cannot avail of this grant to attend a residency they have already attended.
- The awardee will be required to sign a Letter of Agreement to complete the selection process.

Deliverables:

Upon completion of the residency, the awardee must submit photo documentation of his/her experience and work, along with a certificate of completion for SAF internal records
